

## Club Notes.

Sixteen meetings of the Club were held during the year, with an average attendance of twenty-one.

At the thirty-fifth stated meeting of the American Ornithologists' Union, held at Cambridge, Mass., November 13th to 15th, 1917, the following D. V. O. C. members were present: Henry W. Fowler, J. Three field trips were taken during the year, as follows:

*February 22, 1917.* The Washington Birthday Field Trip was conducted in the vicinity of New Lisbon, N. J., twenty-five members attending. American Crossbills, Redpolls and Evening Grosbeaks were noted. The Grosbeaks had wintered in the locality, having been seen previously on several occasions.

*April 6, 1917.* A Field Trip was taken on Good Friday about West Chester, Pa. The day was a cloudy one and windy. Thirty-six species of birds were noted, including the Pied-billed Grebe, Pipit and Mockingbird.

*May 30, 1917.* The Decoration Day Field Trip was attended by eight members and was taken along the Delaware River in the region extending from Taylor's Lane, N. J., to Camden. Eighty species of birds were noted. A Night Heron colony was visited. The Least Bittern and Black Tern were among the birds seen.
