

Field Trips

Field trips were taken as follows during the years 1927-1928.

1927. *February 22*, to Ambler, Pa. Seventeen members and four visitors; twenty-six species observed; about fifty Long-eared Owls were seen.

1927. *April 15*, down Delaware river by steamboat to Penns Grove, N. J. From Penns Grove to Salem on foot. Sixteen members and four visitors; fifty-three species observed; Great Blue Heron colony inspected.

1927. *May 28, 29, 30*, a three day auto trip to various points in Delaware. Seventeen members present; one hundred and twenty species were observed; Prothonotary Warbler nesting at upper Choptank River; Glossy Ibis seen at Wilmington, Delaware.

1928. *February 22*, to Stone Harbor N. J. Twenty-eight members and five visitors; forty-two species seen; a large flight of Canada Geese observed.

1928. *April 6*, Delaware City, Delaware. Twenty-three members and two visitors; sixty-five species seen; about fifty Shoveller Ducks, many Green-winged Teal, Blue-winged Teal and Pintail Ducks noted.

1928. *May 30*, to Cape May, N. J. Thirty-three members and six visitors; seventy-nine species observed.
