Bird Studies at Old Cape May, An Ornithology of Coastal New Jersey, by Witmer Stone, 940 pp. 121 plates (two in color). 280 lines cuts. In two volumes, handsomely bound. Out of print. (Dover reprint, 2 vols., out of print; available as Stackpole Books reprint, 1 vol., 2000)

Cassinia. A journal published periodically beginning in 1901, comprising papers relating to the ornithology of eastern Pennsylvania, New Jersey and Delaware, and abstracts of the proceedings of the club. Some back issues still available.

"*Voices of Birds and Birders*," a documentary tape recorded and produced by George B. Reynard. Three 90-minute cassettes of DVOC meetings, speakers, trips, and ornithological discoveries. On two of the six sides are tape recordings of more than 150 species of birds, with names announced for each. Featured are recordings made during DVOC field trips in North and South America. Additional tapes are from the Caribbean, Europe, Africa, and Australia. More than 100 past or present DVOC members are heard on the tapes, giving Christmas count results, spring roundups, local notes, remarkable rarities, and humor.
