Charles was an excellent field birder who had a great ear for bird song. Birding took him all over the United States and Canada in addition to three trips to Australia and one trip each to New Zealand and Jamaica. Some of his birding highlights in the United States were two male Bachman's Warblers in South Carolina in 1951, four California Condors in California in 1979, and two Whooping Cranes in Texas in 1975.

Charles was a member of Hawk Mountain Sanctuary, the World Wildlife Fund, National Wildlife Federation, and the National Audubon Society. He will be missed in the field by his birding friends.
